The Yank Theater opened in 1944 and showed mostly "B" movies. The theater was part of the chain operated by Eddie Joseph (see the *Drive In* in this exhibit for more on Joseph). It was later renamed the Studio 4 and was an adult film theater. As Studio 4 it became embroiled in a legal case when the city raided the theater and arrested the staff for showing "obscene" material. The cases were settled in 1975. Studio 4 closed in 1973 and is now a night club.

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
