Authorize award, negotiation, and execution of 12-month requirements service contract with SECURITY DESIGN, INC. dba EO INTEGRATED SYSTEMS, INC. for airport security system software and hardware maintenance, support services, and training at the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport in an estimated amount not to exceed \$105,000, with three 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$109,000, \$113,200, and \$118,000 respectively, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$445,200.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$45,417 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding for the remaining seven months of the original contract and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.
