## Additional Backup Information

The following amendments to the Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Reinvestment Zone No. 18 (Seaholm Redevelopment Project) are under consideration:

- Increase in geographic boundary of the TIF Zone with the addition of Gables Park Plaza Phase II and the Bowie Underpass
- Increase in project costs for the street work and the Bowie Bicycle and Pedestrian Underpass and therefore, an increase in debt to be incurred
- Increase in projected tax revenue

In addition, the recent revision to Chapter 311 of the Texas Tax Code (the "Act") provides that the composition of the TIF Board shall consist of members appointed by participating taxing entities of the Zone. The City is the only taxing entity participating in the Zone. Therefore, Travis County will no longer have a representative on the Board.
