SUBJECT: Interdepartmental Agreement for the Provision of Reclaimed Water Service to Hancock Park

Austin Water (AW) and the Parks and Recreation Department (PARC) have worked together to prepare for the provision of reclaimed water from the Walnut Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant for irrigation use at Hancock Golf Course (Park). Specifically, AW is funding the construction of a reclaimed water irrigation system that PARC is constructing at the Park.

In anticipation of the use of reclaimed water at the Park, it is important to document the agreement under which reclaimed water will be supplied. Over the past year numerous meetings and discussions have taken place between AWU and PARC staff. The points agreed upon are as follows:

- PARC shall design, construct, and manage the construction of a reclaimed water irrigation system and associated plumbing improvements at the Park, including a meter vault, reclaimed backflow preventer and the connection to a reclaimed water main in Red River.
- The reclaimed water irrigation system and associated improvements shall be reviewed, approved, built, and inspected according to City standards, codes, and ordinances for reclaimed water irrigation systems.
- AW shall provide funding from its Capital Improvement Budget for PARC's design, and construction of the reclaimed water irrigation system. AW shall track the amount of funding for reimbursement purposes.
- From time to time AW acquires easements from PARC for the construction of potable water, reclaimed water, and wastewater facilities. AW pays for these easements following a PARC valuation process. PARC shall reimburse AW for the funding of the reclaimed irrigation system and associated plumbing improvements at the Park as AW acquires easements.
- PARC shall own, operate, and maintain the reclaimed water irrigation system and associated plumbing improvements.


- PARD shall pay the reclaimed water rate for its reclaimed water irrigation system use.
- Based on reclaimed system models, we will be able to provide up to 1,500 gpm at a working pressure in the 50 to 65 psi range.
