**WHEREAS**, vehicle, rail, bicycle and pedestrian safety are paramount to Austin's transportation system; and

**WHEREAS**, as a community we have recently experienced several fatal accidents involving all modes of transportation which highlight the need for transportation safety awareness; and

**WHEREAS**, as a community we are encouraging multi-modal transportation options; and

**WHEREAS**, transportation safety is critical to getting more folks to switch from single occupancy vehicle to public transit, pedestrian, and bicycle modes of transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, in the past we have received input and recommendations from stakeholder groups such as the “Street Smarts Task Force” that have been used to make policy decisions; and

**WHEREAS**, transportation safety involves multiple jurisdictions including but not limited to, the City of Austin, Capital Metro, Travis County, Texas Departments of Transportation and Public Safety; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Manager is directed to support a Transportation Safety Summit with the appropriate staff to discuss current transportation system conditions and provide recommendations for the relevant jurisdictions on improving transportation safety; and
