Prior Council Action:	<p>September 28, 2006: Council approved Ordinance No. 20060928-020, amending regulations applicable to mobile food vendors and providing that neighborhood associations could submit an application to the City of Austin requesting that mobile food establishments comply with additional distance requirements.</p> <p>January 31, 2008: Council approved Ordinance No. 20080131-133, amending regulations applicable to mobile food establishments, allowing planning area contact teams to submit an application, and providing notification to the mobile food vendors of the neighborhood applications.</p> <p>May 15, 2008: Council approved Ordinance No. 20080515-030 designating certain neighborhood association areas as subject to additional distance requirements for mobile food vendors.</p>

There are two ways a neighborhood association and neighborhood planning area may request that additional regulations for mobile food establishments apply to the mobile food establishments located in their neighborhood area: (1) submit a request during the neighborhood planning process; or; (2) submit an application during the open filing period in February.

The following neighborhood organizations have requested that the additional restrictions on mobile food establishments apply to their area: North Lamar Neighborhood Planning Area and Stone Gate Neighborhood Association.

The Planning and Development Review Department (PDRD) recommends that the map indicating areas with additional regulations for mobile food establishments be amended to include the above mentioned neighborhood associations.
