Staff recommends approval of this code amendment. Currently, pedicabs are considered taxi cabs, and regulated the same as their larger automotive counterparts. Specifically, it is currently only allowed in Downtown Mixed Use (DMU) and Central Business District (CBD) zoning districts as conditional uses.						
In contrast, bicycle sales and services are considered as a general retail sales (convenience) use, and permitted in most commercial districts. The new pedicab use would have impacts closer to those of a bicycle rental store, and staff recommends it be permitted at a similar level.
