

Additional Backup Information

On January 31 of this year, Atmos Energy Corporation, Mid-Tex Division, filed for an increase in its system-wide annual rates by \$49.0 million, or 4.36% including gas costs or 11.94% excluding gas costs. Under the Gas Utilities Regulatory Act (Chapters 101 through 105 of the Texas Utilities Code), the City has original jurisdiction over gas utility rates set for customers within its city limits. Atmos Energy has approximately 6,300 customers in the City of Austin limits.

On March 1, 2012, the City Council adopted an ordinance suspending the effective date of the proposed increase to no later than June 4, 2012, as provided by state law. Austin is a member of the Atmos Texas Municipalities (ATM) which is a coalition of cities that are affected by the rate increase who jointly hired experts to properly review the filing.

The City Charter requires Council to hold a public hearing prior to taking any action that affects rates of a franchise holder.

Staff recommends approval.
