- 1. There were 2 (two) citizens to speak under citizen's communication or to address the Board under specific agenda items.
- 2. The minutes of 3/19/2008 were postponed to the next Environmental Board meeting of 4/16/2008.
- 3. The Environmental Board made a motion to adopt the City of Austin Standard Bylaws. See attached.
- 4. The Environmental Board recommends conditional approval of a variance request to Land Development Code 1) 25-8-261 – To construct improvements in the Critical Water Quality Zone, and 2) LDC 25-8-301 - To Construct driveways on slopes greater than 15% for the Travis County Southeast Metro Park 8" Raw Water Line. See attached.
- 5. The Environmental Board recommends denial of the appeal related to protected tree removal on lot 5 of the Enclave at Gracywoods, Block A. See attached.

- 6. The Environmental Board recommends conditional approval of a variance request to Land Development Code Section 9-10-409(a) (b) -To exceed the four foot cut/fill limits for Concordia University. See attached.
- 7. The Environmental Board recommends that the City Council release to the City of Jonestown approximately 239 acres from the City of Austin's E.T.J. See attached.
