Additional Backup Information

This action will authorize the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with the University of Texas at Austin in an amount not to exceed \$240,000 to acquire access to conference services and facilities. The UT Commons Center will provide conference rooms, audio-visual equipment rentals, and catering services for various events and classes planned throughout the year to the Austin Police Department.

Under this agreement, the Austin Police Department agrees to reimburse the University of Texas at Austin for services in an amount not to exceed \$240,000, including fees and expenses. This agreement is effective on the date the agreement is signed by the last of the parties ("Effective Date"). This Contract shall be in effect for an initial term of 36 months and may be extended thereafter for up to three (3) additional 12 month periods, subject to the approval of the Contractor and the City Purchasing Officer or designee.
