Authorize award and execution of Amendment No. 1 to a contract with SARTIN SERVICES, INC., to install a Wireless Vital Signs Monitor (WVSM) in an ambulance bus for Emergency Medical Services in an amount not to exceed \$109,750 for a revised total contract amount not to exceed \$496,076.33.

This contract is for a modification to an order for one Medical Ambulance Bus (MAB) for the Emergency Medical Services Department. On November 10, 2011, the Austin City Council approved the purchase of one (1) medical ambulance bus (MAB) in the amount of \$386,326.33. This purchase was part of a statewide initiative by the Texas Division of Emergency Management and the Texas Department of State Health Services whereby 16 MABs will be stationed in various cities throughout the State of Texas. This amendment will allow for Sartin Services, Inc. to install a Wireless Vital Signs Monitor (WVSM) system that will provide monitoring and wireless transmission of vital signs (ECG, blood pressure and blood oxygenation) for multiple patients via non-invasive blood pressure cuffs.
