


> Chapter 26 Application For Temporary & Permanent Use Of Park Land

This project will replace about 700 linear feet of old wastewater main that was originally installed in the 1930's. 111 linear feet of the original line goes under Hemphill Park.




• The new wastewater line will also cross under the park, but in a new location downstream.



• Special precautions will be taken for excavation close to the rock walls of the drainage channel. The existing rock walls will not be cut. The new wastewater pipe will be placed under the walls in a hand dug tunnel.

•The channel bottom will be trenched to place the pipe and the trench will be repaired with rock and mortar.





 Existing missing parts of the drainage channel bottom, from Wheeler Street to the storm water outlet (approximately 165 linear feet) will be repaired with rock and mortar by this project as mitigation and payment for use of Park land.
