Authorize award and execution of a 24-month requirements supply agreement with LEOTEK ELECTRONICS USA CORPS. for LED incandescent traffic signal lamps 12-inch LED traffic signal lamp unit for the Transportation Department in an amount not to exceed \$111,960 with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$55,980 for each option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$279,900.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$23,325 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Transportation Department. Funding for the remaining 19 months of the original contract period and for the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.
