This project will replace the inlet grate and repair the outlet gate of the Barton Springs Pool Bypass Tunnel.

The existing inlet grate is severely damaged, provides limited service access, and captures significant amounts of debris, causing overflows at the upstream dam. The new inlet grate will enhance access to the bypass culvert for large equipment, allow future replacement of damaged segments of the grate, and reduce buildup of debris.

The current outlet gate is corroded and does not close properly, leaving the bypass culvert unsecured. The proposed repair consists of replacing the damaged portions of the gate and installing a latching mechanism to lock the gate.

The contract allows 105 calendar days for completion of this project. This project is located within zip code 78704. This project is managed by the Public Works Department.
