From Will Mc Lead

- Current Council is elected At-Large
- Consists of 6 Council Members, and
- 1 Mayor
- Filing Fee is \$500
- Term is at 3 Years.

- A unique proposal is needed for the City Of Austin to be fairly represented, while keeping the costs of city government fairly restrained.
- In the next slide, I will explain.

- 4 Council Members will represent Single Member Districts. Renamed to Ward (I.E. Northwest Ward.)
- Those council members would be elected by registered voters in those areas.
- Those areas will be divided by sides of Austin geographically
- (1) Northwest, (1) Northeast, (1) Southeast, and (1) Southwest Austin

- 4 seats to be elected At-Large, but represent the Single Member District jurisdiction.
- (1) Northwest (2) Northeast (3) Southeast and (4) Southeast
- Elected citywide, but their jurisdiction is limited to those quadrants.

- Term Limits
- 2 Years
- 2 Terms
 - Filing Fee
- Reduced to \$100 or 1% signatures
- Application fee of \$25 in addition to Filing Fee.

-Council Member's Salary

Reduced to \$45,000 each Council Member

-Council members who receive Disability, can negotiate a lower salary

Mayor's Salary

-Reduced to \$50,000 a year

Current Salaries

- Council Members \$64,043 exception of one

-Council Member Tovo \$62,795

- Reduce to \$25,000 a Year
- 1 Council Aide per Council
- 1 Aide per Mayor



- Fair Representation
- 2 Heads are better than 1
 - -Each District would be represented by 2 however 1 would be elected at-large
- Attracts more city involvement by lowering the filing fee.

- * Think before doing a 10-1 Plan!
- * Current Council Members right now are 6 making more than \$60,000 not including Council Aides
- *10-1 Makes a Bigger Problem into a smaller Problem
- * Increases the size and cost of government.

- San Antonio has had Single Member Districts since 1977, since 1977 a lot of areas around San Antonio has declined in growth, areas such as East San Antonio Austin Hwy to Dietrich, W.W. White Road, South New Braunfels, and E Houston Street.
- The Outskirts such as 1604 at I-35 outside of San Antonio Proper have grown



- Council Member's will be appointed to District by Public Vote
- Will not go into effect until the Next Even Numbered November Election, which should be on November 2014.
- Those who are term limited will not qualify.
