

**ORDINANCE NO. 20120628-077**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20100527-048 RENEWING A FRANCHISE TO GREATER AUSTIN TRANSPORTATION COMPANY D.B.A. YELLOW CAB COMPANY TO ALLOW FOR ADDITIONAL TAXICAB PERMITS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** Part 2 of Ordinance No. 20100527-048, which renews a franchise to Yellow Cab Company, is amended to read:

**PART 2. FLEET SIZE.**

The franchise holder must maintain an active fleet of at least 25 and not more than [455] 461 taxicabs. No less than six of these taxicabs will be company-owned vehicles. This taxicab allocation may be amended during the course of the franchise.


**PART 2.** The franchise holder shall file its written acceptance of the terms of this amendment to its franchise ordinance, Ordinance No. 20100527-048, with the City Clerk no later than August 24, 2012.

**PART 3.** This ordinance becomes effective on August 28, 2012, unless the franchise holder fails to file its written acceptance of this ordinance as required by Part 2. If the franchise holder fails to file its written acceptance, this ordinance is void.






