# PARD briefing on staff actions to PARB Cemetery Working Group



## PARB Cemetery Working Group Meetings

#### Feb. – Mar. 2012:

 PARB Cemetery Working Group (CWG) hosted 4 facilitated public input meetings to collect and prioritize public concerns, and draft recommendations

#### April 2012:

- PARB CWG finalized and submitted its report and recommendations
- PARB approved the CWG's report and recommendations and forwarded to PARD
  - PARB Cemetery Working Group submitted an issue matrix that included 62 specific citizen concerns presented at the public input meetings by the community, and accepted by PARB

#### May 2012:

PARD staff reviewed recommendations and developed a Draft Action Plan

#### • June 2012:

- PARD submitted the Draft Action Plan to the PARB Cemetery Working Group for preliminary review and comments
- PARD submitted its Final Action Plan to PARB on June 26, 2012

# PARB Cemetery Working Group Recommendations

#### **PARD Action Plan & Status To Date**

#### 1. Provide a quarterly update to PARB

- ✓ PARD has initiated and will continue to provide quarterly updates to PARB
- ✓ PARD will continue to host quarterly Stakeholder meetings
- ✓ PARD has conducted 4 quarterly Stakeholder meetings. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for September 19, 2012

# 2. Revise the 2006 Contract to clarify contractual terms and responsibilities for each of the contracting parties

- ✓ PARD submitted clarified restated agreement to InterCare Corporation in July 2012
- ✓ Restated agreement now includes deleted terms per PARB recommendation
- Restated agreement now includes added Performance Measures
- Anticipate City Council review in September 2012

# 3. Develop a plan and schedule for engaging the public and developing a cemeteries master plan

- ✓ PARD designated Kim McKnight, Preservation Planner and Cultural Resources Specialist to coordinate the Cemetery Master Plan project
- Currently, \$140k is budgeted for this project
- ✓ An additional \$150k has been proposed for FY 2013 as an unmet need for this project

# PARB Cemetery Working Group Recommendations

#### **PARD Action Plan & Status To Date (continued)**

- 4. Review and analyze cemetery contracts from other municipal cemeteries and develop a Request for Proposal that is based on fee-for-services financial model and reflects best practices
  - ✓ PARD is reviewing other municipal cemetery contracts for best practices and will complete this review by August 2012
  - Reviewed 6 cities (San Antonio, TX.; San Marcos, TX.; Ft Lauderdale, FL.; Sultan, WA.; Carlsbad, NM.; Portland, OR.)
- 5. PARD and the Contractor agree to implement by September 30, 2013 a computer-based cemetery management information system
  - PARD is committed to acquire, install, and support a computer based cemetery management system as a condition of the restated agreement process
  - ✓ PARD submitted a technology budget request of \$15k for a computerized records management system in FY 2011 (unfunded), FY 2012 (unfunded), and again for FY 2013



# PARB Cemetery Working Group Recommendations

#### PARD's Response to Additional Working Group Recommendations

- Developed and improved Sales Contracts for time-sales
- Reviewed the equipment needed to maintain the Austin cemeteries and compare to equipment lists since 1990
- ✓ Revised the Cemetery On-site Compliance Form to reflect the clarifications to the contract
- ✓ Updated the Public Cemeteries' Water Plan to reflect forestry best practices
- ✓ Proposed in the FY 2013 budget a full-time position for a Cemetery Contract Administrator
- Created Customer Information packets for cemetery plot customers

# PARD is in concurrence and is responding to these recommendations:

- Analyze the Perpetual Care Fund
- Create a plan for increased enforcement of Cemetery Rules and Regulations
- Update the City website to better market municipal cemetery services
- Explore expanding revenue and providing more choice to the public
