

Approval of this budget amendment for \$2,060,000 will allow the Department to fund the purchase of a Multiplexing Optical Network System, hardware components, supporting devices, optical network management and network design modeling software, integration and implementation services.

The current fiber optic network, COATN, is out of manufacturer support by December of 2014 and cannot support the current and future telecommunication projects due to a lack of capacity to transmit large amounts of data and lack adequate bandwidth. The City can ensure adequate bandwidth resources for many years to come by upgrading the fiber optic electronics to Dense Wave Division Multiplexing (DWDM) technology. This technology will enable the city's network infrastructure to accommodate next generation form of data activity on the network (proliferation of video web streaming, video training, video teleconferencing and event monitoring).
