The purpose of this project is to provide polymer modified asphalt sealer (micro – surfacing) with related crack sealing, patching, level ups and remarking of the roadway to extend the life of the pavement on Presidential Boulevard, the entry and exit roads of Presidential Boulevard, and an adjoining section of road. This project also provides for the removal, realignment and replacement of street markings.
