Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements service contract with THYSSENKRUPP AIRPORT SYSTEMS, dba THYSSEN AG, to provide operational and emergency repairs for passenger boarding bridges at the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport in an estimated amount not to exceed \$878,000, with three 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$310,000 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$1,808,000.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$35,833 is available in the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Operating Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding for the remaining 34 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.
