### **D. ITEMS FOR COMMISSION'S REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION FOR APPROVAL TO CITY COUNCIL**

1. Recommend approval to award and execute a contract with **AUSTIN GENERATOR SERVICE** for the purchase and installation of an emergency generator at the Guildford Pump Station for the Austin Water Utility in an amount not to exceed \$70,950.
2. Recommend approval to award and execute a 36-month requirements service contract with **AUSTIN ARBORIST COMPANY**, dba **AUSTIN TREE EXPERTS; FOREVER GREEN TROPICALS PLANT LEASING, INC.**, dba **FOREVER GREEN; RIOS TREE SERVICE, INC.**; and **UNITY CONTRACTOR SERVICES, INC.** (MBE/MB), or one of the other qualified bidders for IFB-BV No. SAP0135, to provide tree-trimming and removal services for various City Departments in an estimated amount not to exceed \$3,602,000 each and combined, with three 12-month extension options in estimated amounts not to exceed \$1,286,100 for the first extension option, each and combined; \$1,332,405 for the second extension option, each and combined; and \$1,381,025 for the third extension option, each and combined; for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$7,601,530 each and combined.

3. Recommend approval to award and execute a 24-month requirements service contract with **WASTEWATER TRANSPORT SERVICES, LLC.**, to provide emergency response for sludge and sewage pumping, hauling, and disposal services for the Austin Water Utility in an estimated amount not to exceed \$400,000, with one 24-month extension option in an estimated amount not to exceed \$400,000 for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$800,000.
4. Recommend approval to award and execute two contracts through the Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments (HGAC) with **MENZI USA SALES, INC.**, Lakeland, FL for the purchase of a walking excavator in an amount not to exceed \$322,522 and with **SANTEX TRUCK CENTERS, LTD.** for twenty-one truck chassis in an amount not to exceed \$2,689,734.
5. Recommend approval to award and execute four contracts through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard) with **CLS EQUIPMENT CO.** for the purchase of one Ford E450 fully equipped TV inspection van body in an amount not to exceed \$143,554; **PHILPOTT MOTORS** for the purchase of 22 medium-duty service vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$1,052,840; **PROFESSIONAL TURF PRODUCTS** for the purchase of four mowers and a trailer in an amount not to exceed \$129,175; and **KIRBY SMITH MACHINERY, INC.** for the purchase of five vibratory rollers and one trailer in an amount not to exceed \$64,705.
6. Recommend approval to award and execute ten contracts through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard) with: **BOBCAT COMPANY** for the purchase of 3 skid-steer loaders in an amount not to exceed \$178,364; **COOPER EQUIPMENT** for the purchase of a gooseneck trailer in an amount not to exceed \$77,331; **RDO EQUIPMENT** for the purchase of one track loader, one skid loader, one track loader and one backhoe in an amount not to exceed \$393,488, **FREIGHTLINER OF AUSTIN** for the purchase of 16 heavy-duty vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$1,794,760; **CHASTANG'S BAYOU CITY AUTOCAR** for the purchase of 11 Autocar refuse truck chassis in the amount of \$1,532,154; **RUSH TRUCKS** for the purchase of 2 UD refuse truck chassis in an amount not to exceed \$185,316; **LONGHORN INTERNATIONAL** for the purchase of 1 Carne Carrier CNG refuse truck chassis in an amount not to exceed \$246,922; **HEIL OF TEXAS** for the purchase of 19 Heil refuse bodies in an amount not to exceed \$2,479,122; **GRANDE TRUCK CENTER** for the purchase of 2 Mack truck chassis in an amount not to exceed \$231,416 and **EQUIPMENT SOUTHWEST** for the purchase of 3 hydraulic loading arms and 2 sidewalk sweepers in an amount not to exceed \$344,837.

7. Recommend approval to award and execute Amendment No. 1 to a contract through the State of Texas Procurement and Support Services Cooperative Program (TPASS) Cooperative Purchasing with **XEROX CORPORATION** and **CANON USA, INC.**, to add two 12-month extension options for the rental of multi-function document imaging machines for various City departments, including copy charges and related services, in an amount not to exceed \$960,651 per extension option, for a total revised contract amount not to exceed \$2,750,388.
8. Recommend approval to award and execute a 36-month requirements supply contract with **F. J. TURNER COMPANY**, for the purchase of manhole extension rings and risers for the Austin Water Utility in an estimated amount not to exceed \$408,900 with one 36-month extension option in the estimated amount not to exceed \$408,900, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$817,800.
9. Recommend approval to execute a construction contract with **KST ELECTRIC, LTD.**, for the Hornsby Bend Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition System (SCADA) Improvements ReBid in an amount not to exceed \$631,848, plus a \$63,184 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$695,032.
10. Recommend approval of change order #1 to the construction contract with **QUEST CIVIL CONSTRUCTORS TEXAS, LLC** for the Govalle Tunnel Centralized Odor Control Phase I and II project in the amount of \$282,770 plus additional contingency in the amount of \$195,171.10, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$4,576,534.20.
11. Recommend approval to execute change order #2 to the construction contract with **MCLEAN CONSTRUCTION, INC.**, for Airport at Chesterfield Wastewater Improvements in an amount of \$942,071.13 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$7,120,709.13.
12. Recommend approval to negotiate and execute a two-year **Interlocal Agreement** with the University of Texas (UT) for consulting services regarding characterization of the influent to the City's wastewater treatment plants for a total amount not to exceed \$135,000.
13. Recommend approval of Austin Water Utility's FY 2013 Proposed \$517.9 million Operating Budget, \$42.5 million Capital Budget appropriations, \$1.0 billion 5-Year CIP Spending Plan, and 5.5% system-wide rate increase (5.0% water, 6.0% wastewater, and 10.8% reclaimed).
