ORDINANCE NO. 20120802-061

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-64(D) OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD A PORTION OF RALPH ABLANEDO DRIVE TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MPH AT CERTAIN TIMES FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING WILLIAMS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; AND TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add:

Ralph Ablanedo Drive from 200 feet west of Peaceful Hill Lane to 210 feet east of Peaceful Hill Lane (25 MPH Speed Limit School Zone) (Williams Elementary School).

- **PART 2.** The amendment made in this ordinance is based on the results of a traffic engineering investigation, or "speed study," attached as Exhibit "A".
- **PART 3.** The amendment made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing entries reordered accordingly.
- **PART 4.** Council finds that school will soon be in session, and the need for a school zone at this site constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.

A traffic engineering investigation has been conducted to determine if a reduced speed school zone should be installed on Ralph Ablanedo Drive near Peaceful Hill Lane (the "study intersection) for students attending Williams Elementary School.

Austin Independent School District School (AISD) is discontinuing bus service serving students south of the school beginning with the 2012-2013 school year; therefore, pedestrians living south of Ralph Ablanedo Drive will be required to cross this street if they choose to walk or bicycle between home and school. Figure 1 presents a map of the study area.

The following information was collected and analyzed for this determination.

Proximity of the School Crossing to the School

The proposed school crossing at the study intersection is located approximately one half-mile south of Williams Elementary School. The adjacent land uses are primarily residential as the Park Ridge and Parkridge Gardens Neighborhoods abut Ralph Ablanedo Drive. Automobile part stores and salvage yards are also adjacent to Ralph Ablanedo Drive.

Pedestrian Count

Because the 2012-2013 school year has not begun, no students have been counted crossing Ralph Ablanedo Drive. Pedestrians from the Park Ridge Neighborhood are expected to cross as a result of the discontinued bus service.

Presence of Adult Crossing Guard or Student Safety Patrol

The City's Child Safety Program has committed an adult crossing guard at this intersection if a school zone is established. No guard or patrol currently works this crossing.

Crash History

Austin Police Department's crash database was culled for crashes near the study intersection between June 2011 and June 2012. None were reported during this time period.

Sight Distance

Unobstructed sight distances are approximately 450 feet and 800 feet west and east of Peaceful Hill Lane, respectively, on Ralph Ablanedo Drive.

Sidewalks and Ramps

Sidewalks are along the south curb of Ralph Ablanedo between South 1st Street and Peaceful Hill Lane and the west curb of Peaceful Hill Lane between Ralph Ablanedo Drive and Mairo Street. Accessible ramps are located on the southwest, northwest, and northeast corners of the intersection of Ralph Ablanedo Drive and Peaceful Hill Lane. Pedestrians would use the sidewalk along the south side of Ralph Ablanedo Drive to cross the west leg of the study intersection and use the sidewalk along the west side of Peaceful Hill Lane to access school.

Recommendation

Based on the analysis of this information, it is my engineering judgment that a reduced speed school zone of 25 miles per hour be installed on Ralph Ablanedo Drive from 200 feet west of Peaceful Hill Lane to 210 feet east of Peaceful Hill Lane and operate between 7:00 AM and 8:00 AM and 2:30 PM and 3:30 PM.
