

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MONDAY, AUGUST 20, 2012

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Special Called Meeting on Monday, August 20, 2012, City Hall at 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Leffingwell called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

Mayor Pro Tem Cole and Council Member Spelman were absent.
