

ORDINANCE NO. 20120823-066

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING SUBSTITUTE JUDGES TO THE CITY OF AUSTIN MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE 2010-2013 JUDICIAL TERM TO FILL VACANCIES THAT HAVE ARISEN, AND SETTING THEIR COMPENSATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council finds that the continued efficient operation of the Municipal Court requires that Substitute Judges be available to serve when needed during the remainder of the 2010-2013 term.

PART 2. The City Council appoints the following persons as Substitute Judges for the Municipal Court to fill vacant Substitute Judge positions that have arisen for the remainder of the 2010-2013 term:

Frank Witcher McCullough Olivia Ruiz

PART 3. The Substitute Judges appointed under this Ordinance shall receive the compensation and benefits established for a Substitute Judge by Ordinance No. 20110912-017 and Ordinance No. 20101028-047.

PART 4. The Council finds that maintaining sufficient judicial resources for the Municipal Court affects the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety, and therefore this ordinance takes effect immediately.




