| The number of positions in the Firefighter classification is increasing by thirty-six (36) from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance. These 36 positions are from the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) program grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The Council's commitment to four-person staffing on all Fire apparatus will be fulfilled when the 116 <sup>th</sup> cadet class graduates the thirty-six (36) grant-funded Firefighters in July 2013. |  |             |        |
