## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PARKING BENEFIT DISTRICT (PBD) IN THE UNIVERSITY NEIGHBORHOOD OVERLAY DISTRICT (UNO).

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

**PART 1. FINDINGS.** All application conditions for a parking benefit district in the University Neighborhood Overlay District have been met.

## PART 2. THE UNIVERSITY NEIGHBORHOOD OVERLAY DISTRICT (UNO) PARKING BENEFIT DISTRICT (PBD).

- (A) The UNO PBD is hereby established.
- (B) The PBD will consist of 385 metered parking spaces.
- (C) The PBD is bounded by Guadalupe Street to Rio Grande Street and West 29<sup>th</sup> Street to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. as shown on Exhibit A. The streets included in that boundary are Seton Avenue, 24<sup>th</sup> 26<sup>th</sup> Streets, Nueces Street, San Antonio Street, and 21<sup>st</sup> 28<sup>th</sup> Streets.

## PART 3. IMPROVEMENTS TO BE FUNDED.

Revenue from the UNO PBD will fund sidewalk upgrades within the UNO PBD at the following locations:

- (A) 25th St. from Guadalupe to Block on 25th just west of Rio Grande;
- (B) 21st. St. from Guadalupe to San Gabriel;
- (C) 22nd St. from Guadalupe to Leon St.;
- (D) 26th St. from Guadalupe to Leon St.; and
- (E) 25th St. from Rio Grande to Lamar.
