The agreement is funded with federal and local housing funds in an amount not to exceed \$6,102,960. The AHFC will manage and operate various City Housing programs during Fiscal Year 2012-2013, including renter assistance, homebuyer assistance, homeowner assistance and housing developer assistance - see Exhibit A (AHFC Grant Operating Budget) for details.
