

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

BUDGET WORK SESSION MEETING WEDNESDAY AUGUST 22, 2012

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Budget Work Session Meeting on Wednesday, August 22, 2012, City Hall at 301 W. Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Leffingwell called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m.
