

ORDINANCE NO. 20120927-075

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PARKING BENEFIT DISTRICT (PBD) IN THE UNIVERSITY NEIGHBORHOOD OVERLAY DISTRICT (UNO).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. FINDINGS. All application conditions for a parking benefit district in the University Neighborhood Overlay District have been met.

PART 2. THE UNIVERSITY NEIGHBORHOOD OVERLAY DISTRICT (UNO) PARKING BENEFIT DISTRICT (PBD).

- (A) The UNO PBD is hereby established.
- (B) The PBD will consist of 385 metered parking spaces.
- (C) The PBD is bounded by Guadalupe Street to Rio Grande Street and West 29th Street to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. as shown on Exhibit A. The streets included in that boundary are Seton Avenue, 24th - 26th Streets, Nueces Street, San Antonio Street, and 21st - 28th Streets.


PART 3. IMPROVEMENTS TO BE FUNDED.

Revenue from the UNO PBD will fund sidewalk upgrades within the UNO PBD at the following locations:

- (A) 25th St. from Guadalupe to Block on 25th just west of Rio Grande;
- (B) 21st. St. from Guadalupe to San Gabriel;
- (C) 22nd St. from Guadalupe to Leon St.;
- (D) 26th St. from Guadalupe to Leon St.; and
- (E) 25th St. from Rio Grande to Lamar.

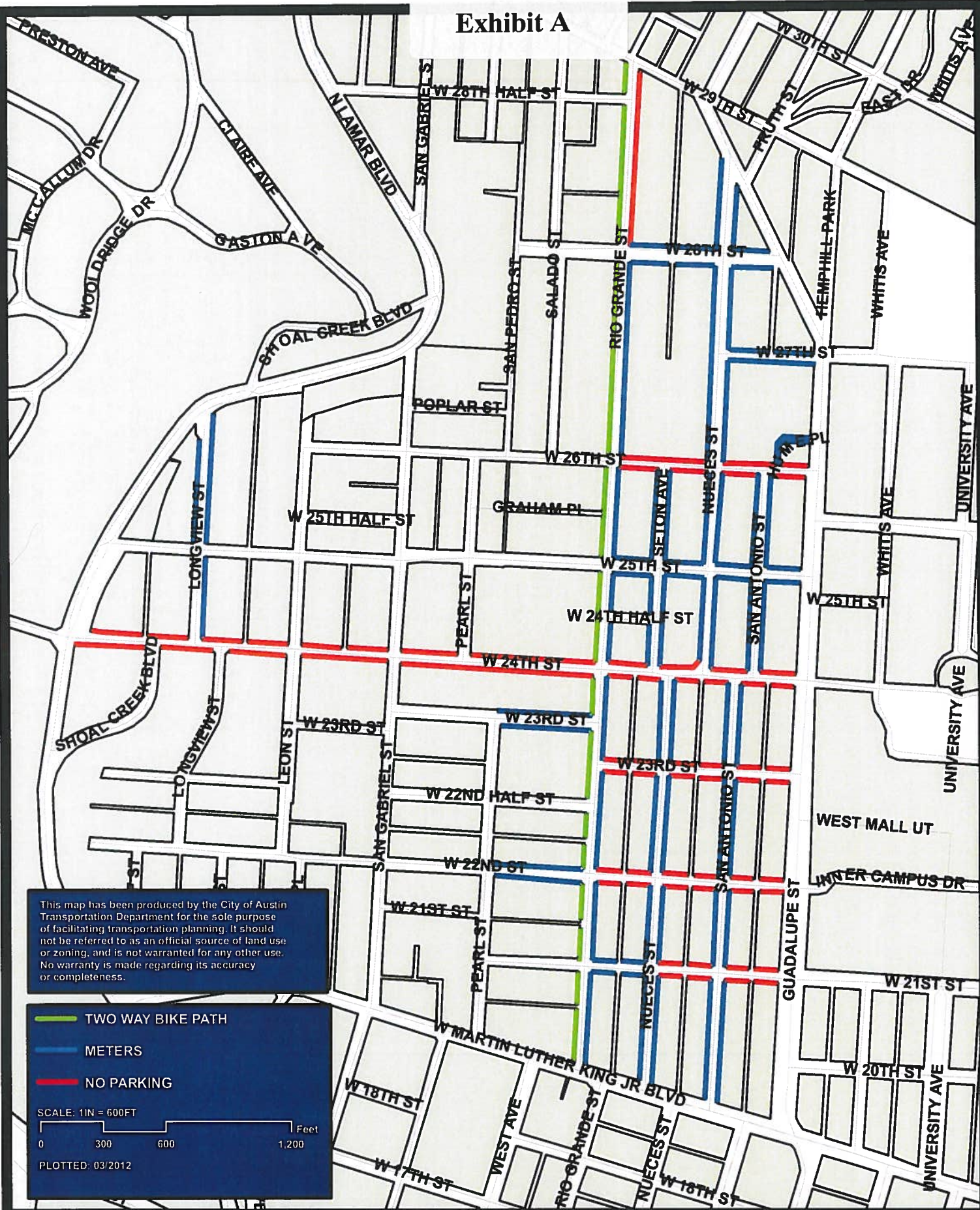
PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on October 8, 2012.
