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- (1) a person or group that deeds the land for the park facility;
- (2) a person or group that contributes the anticipated cost of the development of the park facility;
- (3) a person or group that provides an endowment for the anticipated 20-year maintenance costs of the park facility; or
- (4) a person or subject of community significance including a historic figure; an event or concept; a local, state, or national leader; or an individual or group that has made exceptional contributions to the betterment of the community or the park system.
- (B) Suggestions made on the basis of community significance shall be accompanied by the following:
  - (1) for park facilities less than 2 acres in size, the lesser of 200 signatures representing households within a 0.25-mile radius of the park facility or signatures representing at least 75% of the households within a 0.25-mile radius of the park facility;
  - (2) for park facilities from 2 to 30 acres in size, the lesser of 200 signatures representing households within a 0.50-mile radius of the park facility or signatures representing at least 75% of the households within a 0.50-mile radius of the park facility;
  - (3) for recreation centers and park facilities greater than 30 acres and up to 200 acres in size, the lesser of 600 signatures representing households within a 2-mile radius of the park facility or signatures representing at least 75% of the households within a 2-mile radius of the park facility; or
  - (4) for greenbelts and park facilities greater than 200 acres in size, 1,000 signatures representing households within the city limits.
- (C) In order to be counted under this section, a signature must be accompanied by the legible name and address of the signator.
- (D) The director of the Parks and Recreation Department, with the assistance of the Parks and Recreation Board, shall determine if there are naming opportunities for components, such as rooms or other amenities, within a park facility. The naming of components within a park facility shall be an administrative function of the director.
- (E) The council may by resolution establish different criteria and procedures for the naming of a particular park facility. If a park facility is partially funded by another entity, the council shall consider that entity's concerns in naming the facility.
