Authorize award and execution of two 24-month requirement supply contracts for the supply of miscellaneous utility supplies for the Austin Water Utility with MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS SUPPLY, in an estimated amount not to exceed \$48,884, with two 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$24,442 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$97,768; and with FERGUSON WATERWORKS, in an estimated amount not to exceed \$28,126, with two 12-month extension option in an estimated amount not to exceed \$14,063 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$56,252.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$38,505 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Austin Water Utility. Funding for the remaining 12-months of the original contract periods and extension options is contingent on available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

PRICE ANALYSIS

- a. Adequate competition.
- b. One hundred thirty-two notices were sent include three MBEs and one WBE firm. Four bids were received, none of which were MBE or WBE firms. One "No Bid" response was received.
- c. The current pricing represents a 22% decrease from the previous contracts awarded August 2008. This can be attributed to the greater quantities being purchased under the new contracts.
- d. Municipal Water Works is one of the previous contract providers for these products.
