This contract is for the purchasing and installation of approximately 15,460 feet of fencing/water-gap installation at seven sites within the Water Quality Protections Lands. The project sites are located in Travis and Hays County predominately in a rural setting, but with some next to a rural neighborhood, suburban parks, or suburban roadway. Work will include the removal and disposal of existing dilapidated fencing within these sites and the installation of new fencing, gates, and tree braces where needed.

#### **PRICE ANALYSIS**
