## Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 12-month requirements supply contract with LIBRARY IDEAS, LLC to provide downloadable licensed-content from the Sony Music Entertainment catalog for the Austin Public Library Department in an estimated amount not to exceed \$69,650, with five 12-month extension options in an estimated amount not to exceed \$69,500 per extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$417,150.

## Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$69,650 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Austin Public Library. Funding for the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Freegal Music Service is a subscription which provides registered Austin Public Library cardholders the ability to download licensed content from the Sony Music Entertainment catalog. All of the downloadable content is available in an MP3 format with no DRM (Digital Rights Management). This service is compatible with PC, Mac, and other mobile devices and allows the user to download the content into their iTunes.

This is a sole source procurement since Library Ideas, LLC created and owns Freegal Music Service. No other provider is authorized to distribute or license the Sony Music Entertainment catalog for the purposes of allowing downloads through a public library.
