Due to the sensitivity of this area, these ponds require specialized vegetation management that ensures minimal disturbance to the natural surroundings. Under this contract, each pond will be mowed at least four times a year and invasive woody plants will be removed as needed. This level of maintenance will ensure each pond is compliant with the Environmental Criteria Manual, Drainage Criteria Manual, and dam maintenance policies and procedures while following site-specific IPM plans.
