Additional Backup Information						
 Travis County has been negotiating an agreement with TXI Operations, LP (TXI) the essential elements of which include: (1) TXI foregoing the use of public roads other than a single crossing of Dunlap Road; (2) TXI donating real property to Travis County for open space or parkland; (3) TXI selling to Travis County property to serve as a buffer between the mining operation and neighborhoods; (4) TXI agreeing to prohibit mining and industrial uses on property it owns now and property it may own in the future. 						
Although the original negotiations contemplated a tri-party agreement among Travis County, TXI, and the City, as negotiations proceeded it became clear the City's involvement could be more efficiently and appropriately handled through adoption of an ordinance by the City rather than the City being a party to the agreement.						

The ordinance presented for consideration provides the following variances:

- 1. To allow construction in a Critical Water Quality Zone (LDC Section 25-8-392) for creek crossings for a haul road and bridge structure.
- 2. To allow cut up to 10 feet (LDC 25-8-341) for construction of a haul road or conveyor.
- 3. To allow fill up to 10 feet (LDC 25-8-342) for construction of a haul road or conveyor.
- 4. To allow construction in the Critical Water Quality Zone (LDC 25-8-392) for an internal haul road and/or conveyor.
- 5. To allow a reduced setback for wetlands (LDC 25-8-281).
- 6. To provide that each site plan expires (LDC 25-5-81) only if work on each site ceases for a period of one year or more.
- 7. To establish that the regulations applicable (LDC 25-1-533) to the two mining sites described in Exhibit A are those in effect on January 29, 2010.

The ordinance establishes conditions for the variances that are commonly required for similar variances on other projects in Austin. These conditions provide for protection of Gilleland and Elm creeks through enhanced erosion and sedimentation controls and mitigation land to offset encroachment into wetland buffers.
