

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2012

The City Council of Austin, Texas convened in a Council Special Called Meeting on Saturday, September 22, 2012, at the First United Methodist Church, 1201 Lavaca St., Austin, Texas.

Mayor Pro Tem Cole called the Council Meeting to order at 11:19 a.m. Mayor Leffingwell and Council Members Morrison and Spelman were absent.

Attend the Austin Interfaith "The Many Faces of Homelessness" event for purposes of participating in the "Concluding Remarks by WalterMoreau (Foundation Communities), responses from Austin City Council members, and Austin Interfaith Call to Action" Session.

Each Council Member present was asked to talk about what the City is willing/able to do to develop a "culture of care" for the homeless and steps the City intends to take to address the homeless issue.

Mayor Pro Tem Cole adjourned the meeting at 11:58 a.m. without objection.
