## ORDINANCE NO. 20121011-082

## AN ORDINANCE WAIVING TEMPORARY VENDING PERMIT FEES REQUIRED UNDER CITY CODE CHAPTER 10 FOR THE 14<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL GREEN CORN PROJECT FUNDRAISER WHICH IS TO BE HELD ON OCTOBER 28, 2012 AT THE BOGGY CREEK FARM.

## **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** Council finds that the Green Corn Project is a nonprofit corporation. Its fundraiser is open to the public and serves the public purpose of promoting a healthy environment by reducing the use of toxic materials in gardening. This event also provides a family friendly civic activity.

**PART 2.** Council waives the requirement for temporary vending permit fees required under City Code Section 10-3-64 for the Green Corn Project Fundraiser which is to be held on October 28, 2012 at Boggy Creek Farm in an amount not exceed \$750.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on October 22, 2012.
