Additional Backup Information

The term of this agreement is February 1, 2012 – August 31, 2013. The Agreement may renew annually for up to six (6) additional terms upon the mutual consent of the City and ACC. AFD shall provide and pay the salaries, benefits, and payroll taxes for qualified instructors serving as adjunct ACC faculty. Courses shall be taught at AFD training facilities. ACC shall review and approve the course curriculums and maintain the related records. ACC shall grant continuing education certificates to AFD employees who have completed and passed the required course of study. ACC shall be responsible for and shall pay the administrative costs associated with the matriculation of the AFD cadets in the continuing education courses. ACC shall remit to AFD with twenty (20) percent of the state reimbursement received for student contact hours conducted under this Agreement in compensation for City costs related to educational and instructional expenses.
