### Subject

Authorize award and execution of a 36-month service contract with ALTEC, INC., to provide original equipment manufacturer parts and repair services for utility equipment for the Fleet Services Department in an amount not to exceed \$360,050 with three 12-month extension options in estimated amounts not to exceed \$168,910 for the first extension option, \$201,742 for the second extension option, and \$241,141 for the third extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$971,843.

# Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$91,437 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Fleet Services Department. Funding for the remaining twenty-five months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

This service contract will provide for original equipment manufacturer (OEM) parts and repairs services for Altec, Ford and Sterling utility equipment. The City currently owns and operates various makes and models of utility equipment such as auger drills, cable placers, digger derricks, pressure augers, utility bodies, truck mounted cranes and bucket trucks that will be covered by the services provided by this contract annually and on an as needed basis.

This equipment will be serviced on-site by the contractor's technicians. In the case that the equipment cannot be repaired at the City's facility the vendor will transport the equipment to their local repair facility.
