Additional Backup Information

The Circuit of the Americas annexation area (approximately 1,521 acres) is located in Travis County south of Pearce Lane approximately one half mile east of the intersection of Pearce Lane and Ross Road. This area is currently in the city's extraterritorial jurisdiction and is adjacent to the city's full purpose jurisdiction on the northwest side. This area includes undeveloped land owned by the State of Texas in addition to undeveloped agricultural parcels, a segment of the right-of-way of Elroy Road, and the Circuit of the Americas site.
