No report on Commercial Site Plan, no accurate numbers at this point. Private Tree Permits numbers indicate number of caliber inches. This time of year, increase in requests for grants. Public gets information from website and talks with neighborhood groups. Tree inventory has commenced. Brought on by Environmental Board's working group. Downtown tree inventory started and will last to end of the year. Public and private properties in central business district Lamar to, MLK to I35 to the River.
