# Subject

Authorize award and execution of Amendment No. 8 to a contract with AUSTIN FREE-NET, to provide computer equipment, technical support, internet training, and internet access services to support public internet access, to expand its public computer centers to geographical areas not currently served such as Montopolis, Dove Springs, Palm Square and others, and to increase the contract in an amount not to exceed \$143,958 for the final extension option, for a revised total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$718,895, for the Telecommunications and Regulatory Affairs Department.

# Additional Backup Information

This agreement provides computer equipment, technical support, internet training, and internet access services to support public internet access. Austin Free-Net currently serves 25 sites with computers and digital devices along with training to educate clients to become independent computers users. Through training they provide technical literacy and education. They assist clients with job searches, basic computer training through advanced computer training on topics such as Word, Excel and social media. The purpose of this amendment is provide gap funding and to expand the public computer centers to geographical areas not currently served such as Montopolis, Dove Springs, Palm Square and others. This agreement is administered by the Telecommunications and Regulatory Affairs (TARA) Department.

This contract was awarded as a sole source in January 2003. The City reaffirmed the sole source in 2008 with Council action item 63 and continues this determination through this council request in 2012. This recommended Council action is to approve Amendment No. 8 for \$143,958 for a final contract value of \$718,895.
