6. Election of Austin Community Technology and Telecommunications Commission officers.

9. Staff update on strategic vision for community media capital investment. (Rondella Hawkins) (wp1)

Rondella Hawkins, City of Austin Office of Telecommunications & Regulatory Affairs (TARA) Director reported that Public, Educational, and Governmental (PEG) fees are remitted by cable providers to the City for capital expenditures related to PEG channel operations, and therefore the final decision on how the PEG fees are used resides with the City.

TARA is working with the PEG stakeholders to establish the policies and procedures to be followed to determine how the PEG fees are allocate. This Commission will invite PEG stakeholders to participate in its January 2013 meeting to present their suggestions. Additional comments from the general public will also be received at this meeting.

The Commissions was requested to submit names of PEG stakeholders or others the Commission would like to invite to participate in the round table discussion in January. (i.e. PEG Managers, Community radio, community media.....)

Commissioner Rosenthal encouraged the Commission do some out reach for people in the community to come to the public hearing.
