 - 1. C14-2012-0081 Austin High School 1212 Rio Grande Street Proposal: Change zoning from UNZ-H to DMU-H

City Staff: Clark Patterson, Planning and Development Review Department, 974-7691 Staff Recommendation: Postpone to December 17, 2012 at the applicant's request.

MOTION: Approve the applicant's request to postpone to December 17, 2012 on Commissioner Leary's motion; Commissioner Galindo second on a 6-0 vote.

Proposal: Demolish a ca. 1961 house.
Applicant: Ross Rathgeber, Southwest Destructors
City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454
Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic zoning.

No speakers in support. Ross Rathgeber and Ashley Amini spoke in opposition. The public hearing was closed on Commissioner Leary's motion; Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second on a 6-0 vote.

Committee Recommendation: Approve as presented with an itemization of specific work to be performed on the site.

Staff Recommendation: Approve as presented.

No speakers in support or in opposition. Jay Colombo signed in support but did not speak. The public hearing was closed on Commissioner Myers' motion; Commissioner Galindo second on a 6-0 vote (Commissioner Rosato absent from the dias).

Proposal:Demolish a c. 1945 contributing house.Applicant:Janell Ross, Estate of John David PeckCity Staff:Alyson McGee, Historic Preservation Office, 974-7801Committee Recommendation:Not presented to Committee.Staff Recommendation:Approved the Certificate of Appropriateness;however delay release of the demolition permit until a Certificate ofAppropriateness is approved for a replacement building.

Janell Ross spoke in support. Keith Morrison of the City of Austin Arborist Program provided clarifying comments. The public hearing was closed on Commissioner Leary's motion; Commissioner Galindo second on a 7-0 vote.

MOTION: Follow staff's recommendation to delay the release of the demolition permit until a Certificate of Appropriateness is approved for a replacement building on a motion by Commissioner Rosato; Commissioner Roberts second on a 7-0 vote.

4. LHD-2012-0032 – Hyde Park Local Historic District 4104 Duval Street

Proposal: Demolish a c. 1927 non-contributing house and construct a new duplex residence.

Applicant: Jeff Bridgewater

City Staff: Alyson McGee, Historic Preservation Office, 974-7801 Committee Recommendation: Corner boards should be installed prior to horizontal siding. Prefer painted wood windows to clad. Second story roof should be true hipped form. Show more traditional landscaping on renderings. Staff Recommendation: Approve as presented.

No speakers in support or in opposition. Jeff Bridgewater, Mike Jones, Scott Fehr and Barbara Hatcher signed in support but did not speak. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Galindo; Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second on a 7-0 vote. MOTION: Approve the Certificate of Appropriateness as presented on a motion by Commissioner Galindo; Commissioner Leary second on a 7-0 vote.

5. LHD-2012-0034 – Hyde Park Local Historic District Sign Toppers

Proposal: Install signs identifying local historic district above existing street signs.

Applicant: Alyson McGee, Historic Preservation Office

City Staff: Alyson McGee, Historic Preservation Office, 974-7801

Committee Recommendation: Design should be consistent in all districts. Prefer design that is integrated into existing blade signs or that is parallel to the top blade sign. Suggest inclusion of interpretative signage at "gateways" as well. Staff should convene a meeting with representatives of other LHDs and neighborhoods pursuing LHDs to get feedback from those stakeholders. Staff Recommendation: Approve design without the dates indicating the establishment of either the neighborhood or local historic district and install signs parallel to the top street sign blade.

Mr. Fishman signed in support but did not speak. No speakers in opposition. The public hearing was closed on Commissioner Myers' motion; Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry second on a 7-0 vote.

MOTION: Approve the Certificate of Appropriateness and accept staff recommendations on Commissioner Leary's motion; Commissioner Myers second on a 7-0 vote.

603 W. 8th Street

Proposal: Remove the lower retaining walls on both 8th and Nueces Streets for the construction of a sidewalk.

Applicant: City of Austin

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454 Committee Recommendation: Not reviewed.

Staff Recommendation: Retain the retaining walls to the greatest extent possible. The retaining walls are in the right-of-way.

Richard Duane of the City of Austin Public Work's Department spoke in support. No speakers in opposition. The public hearing was close on Commissioner Galindo's motion; Commissioner Roberts second on a 7-0 vote.

MOTION: Retain the retaining walls and encourage the side walk to be built in the street parking spaces that exist on Commissioner Myers' motion; Commissioner X second on a 6-0 -1 vote (Commissioner Wolfenden-Guidry was off the dias)

Proposal: Construct a second story addition and remodel the façade on a c. 1941 non-contributing residence.

City Staff: Alyson McGee, Historic Preservation Office, 974-7801 Staff Recommendation: Release the permit but recommend the applicant consider a design that is more compatible with the neighborhood.

No speakers in support. Greg Browne spoke in opposition. The public hearing was closed on a motion by Commissioner Leary; Commissioner Galindo second on a 7-0 vote.

MOTION: Postpone to December 17, 2012 on Commissioner Leary's motion; Commissioner Galindo second on a 7-0 vote.

City Staff: Alyson McGee, Historic Preservation Office, 974-7801 Staff Recommendation: Recommend the applicant reconsider demolition; however release the permit after review of new construction plans and submittal of a City of Austin Documentation Package consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history for archiving at the Austin History Center.

William Matern and Drew Tate spoke in support. Greg Brown spoke in opposition. William Matern rebuttled. The public hearing was closed on Commissioner Myers' motion; Commissioner Roberts second on a 7-0 vote.

MOTION: Release the demolition permit after new construction design has been reviewed by the Commission and submittal of a City of Austin Documentation Package on Commissioner Rosato's motion; Commissioner Myers second on a 7-0 vote.

3. NRD-2012-0123 3308 Jefferson Street (Old West Austin) Proposal: Construct a new house. Applicant: Ken Johnson, Clayton Little Architects City Staff: Alyson McGee, Historic Preservation Office, 974-7801 Staff Recommendation: Release the building permit with the recommendation that the applicant consider a design more compatible with the architectural character of the neighborhood, and eliminate the paved driveway in the front yard.

Ken Johnson spoke in support. Greg Brown spoke in opposition. Ken Johnson rebuttled. The public hearing was closed on Commissioner Leary's motion. Commissioner Galindo second on a 7-0 vote.
