

ORDINANCE NO. 20121213-056

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN FEES, COSTS, AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2013 AUSTIN FARMER'S MARKETS, A CITY CO-SPONSORED EVENT, DURING THE 2013 CALENDAR YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The 2013 Austin Farmer's Markets, a City co-sponsored event with the Sustainable Food Center, Inc., will be held at Republic Square Park, at the intersection of Triangle Avenue and 46th Street (bordering Triangle Park), and at the East Farmer's Market (near the intersection of East 51st Street and Highway 183) on selected days during the 2013 calendar year. Food vendors for the 2013 Austin Farmer's Markets shall follow the guidelines and requirements of City Code Chapter 8-3 (*Restrictions on Food, Beverage, and Containers*) and Chapter 10-3 (*Food and Food Handlers*).

PART 2. Council waives the following fees and charges for the 2013 Austin Farmer's Markets. Fees that have been paid shall be reimbursed to the Sustainable Food Center, Inc.
