Additional Backup Information

The EMS Department has been providing emergency medical services to Travis County for over thirty years. The most recent Interlocal Agreement Amendment with Travis County for EMS services was signed by the City Manager on August 20, 2011, for FY 2011-2012. The last renewal term expired on September 30, 2012. EMS has continued to provide services to the County through a 120-day "Holdover Period."

This Agreement addresses the City's provision of EMS services to those areas of Travis County that are located outside the City of Austin's corporate limits. Travis County reimburses the City for these services through a flat monthly rate that corresponds to the annual operating budget for EMS. This agreement also addresses City's dispatch support of the County's STAR Flight air ambulance program.
