RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolutions 20101118-061 and 20121206-063 directing the City Manager to allocate \$200,000 toward a master planning process of the Capitol Complex and to negotiate and execute an agreement regarding this master planning process with the Texas Facilities Commission for an amount not to exceed \$400,000 for the Capitol Complex and other identified State-owned properties within the Austin city limits; and

WHEREAS, recent developments at the State Legislature through the Sunset Advisory Commission process have clarified the authority of the Texas Facilities Commission regarding its ability to undertake such a master planning process; and

WHEREAS, it is now evident that a master planning process for the Capitol Complex or other state property within the Austin city limits is now on hold for the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, there exist pressing needs within the City of Austin, namely addressing weatherization needs of low income families, that warrant the expenditure of these additional funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Manager is directed to allocate all funds already identified and budgeted for the aforementioned master planning processes and reallocate those funds to Austin Energy's program for weatherization assistance for low-income families.
