#### Additional Backup Information

Austin Transportation Department staff has vetted this process with taxicab, limousine, charter, and shuttle vehicle stakeholders for a period of one year, and has received favorable input and support from the Austin Police Department.

This particular ordinance will allow for the initiation of the impoundment following the procedures set forth by Texas State laws. A vehicle impoundment process will be initiated in instances where sufficient probable cause exists. The vehicle owner will need to follow the steps specified by State law to retrieve the vehicle.

Other cities in the region, including the City of San Antonio, Texas have served as a model, having a longstanding and successful implementation and enforcement of unpermitted vehicles for hire.

The ordinance provides that it will take effect immediately. This is because of plans announced by some unpermitted operators to violate the City Code requirements during South by Southwest.
