Additional Backup Information

Amendments are proposed for Chapter 25 of the City Code pertaining to the requirements for off-street parking in the Central Business District (CBD), Downtown Mixed Use (DMU), and P-Public zoning districts in the downtown The amendment was initiated by Council Resolution No. 20120426-074 and would eliminate minimum motor vehicle parking requirements for all uses in these districts. Parking would continue to be required for people with disabilities and for bicycles. Off-street loading requirements would also be modified, and off-site accessory parking would become a permitted rather than a conditional use in the downtown area.

Staff recommends the amendment.
