This amendment was initiated by the Planning Commission. Community Events use is defined as a use permitted for an "approved venue project", except for a hotel, zoological park, museum, or aquarium. The use includes the sale of alcoholic beverages. Currently the only permitted area for a Community Events use is the land occupied by the Long Center. The proposed area is the City-owned land located with the area bounded on the north by a line 650 feet north of and parallel to the northern right-of-way of Toomey Road, on the east by the western right-of-way of South Lamar Boulevard, on the south by the northern right-of-way of Toomey Road, and on the west by a line 700 feet west of and parallel to the western right-of-way of South Lamar Boulevard.
